ofuq Foundation is ending its fourth year since its inception with educational projects and significant achievements in the field of education and rehabilitation. The Foundation is continuing the project to accommodate distinguished students who are unable to continue their university education and who are coming from the countryside of Taiz Governorate and neighboring governorates. The number of students benefiting from this service has reached (190) male and female students in various Scientific specializations.

At the level of humanitarian work organizations in Taiz Governorate, it is an educational scholarship project, whether fully or partially covered...

Since the inauguration of this project until now, the Foundation has provided approximately (50 fully covered bachelor's scholarships) as well as (182 (partially covered scholarships) at the level of public or private universities. All of these educational scholarships are allocated to help distinguished students from poor groups and the poorest who are unable to continue their education...

The Foundation has also provided scholarships for master's students (10 scholarships fully or partially covered)...The Foundation has other blessed efforts in the field of education, which is supporting student residence, whether with dry food supplies, from which 400 students benefited, or distributing solar energy. (65) students at the estate level in Taiz Governorate have benefited from this project...

The Foundation has also contributed to distributing charity to needy students, whether to help them with transportation costs or school fees about 260 male and female students benefited from this project.



The Foundation is continuing to build an orphanage and a school affiliated with it in Taiz City, with funding from one of the female philanthropists may Allah reward her with the best reward so that 60 orphans may benefit from the orphanage in its first phase, then in its second phase (120 orphans), with Allah's help...as well as other educational projects, which you will find detailed in this report (achievement report for 2023)...

In this context and with this urgency, we cannot help but express our gratitude and appreciation to everyone who helped the Foundation and provided it with a helping hand, from local or international humanitarian institutions, as well as from benefactors (men and women) at internally and externally as well...



Orphanage & School

The project is located in the area of Taiz - Al-Hasab - Wadi Al-Uqaibat. The area of the project site is (1357) square meters. The place will be allocated to build an orphanage and an attached school for the rehabilitation of orphans with the support of a female philanthropist.

As a first stage, 60 orphans will benefit from the project once it is launched, and the number will increase to 120 orphans at a later stage once the special school for orphan rehabilitation is established.










The project consists of distributing quantities of dry foodstuff to student residences, where the project aims to provide the need of male and female students of the residences for good, healthy food during one academic year.

The project is about distributing winter clothes (winter jackets). It targeted male and female students, orphans and the most needy, in basic schools in the districts of (Saber Al-Mawadim - Al-Selw - Al-Mudaffar). The number of beneficiaries reached 450, and was funded by philanthropists.

Through the school bag distribution project, 226 students were targeted in the Cancer Treatment Center, 74 students were targeted in Al-Misrakh District, and 30 students were targeted in Sabr Al-Mawadim District, with a fund from Sela Foundation for Development. 250 bags were also distributed in Al-Mawasit District and 70 bags were distributed in Al-Shamaytain District for people with special needs, with generous funding from Sela Foundation for Development and philanthropists.


